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EVENT CATEGORY

Events are conducted under the domains of Art, Performing Arts, Music, and Sports.

Activities are conducted in the following categories:

Category	Grade
Junior	Grade V to Grade VIII
Senior	Grade IX to Grade XII
Open Category	Grade V to Grade XII

- > The participating school will announce the competition details, rules and regulations & dates of the selection rounds to their students in advance.
- > The selection rounds are to be conducted at the school level on the dates fixed by the respective schools.
- Selected entries should be sent to the Host School and each School can send the maximum entries for Solo and Group Events as per the following criteria:





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Strength of the School	Solo Events	Group Events
3000 & above	5	4
Between 1000 & 3000	4	3
Between 500 & 1000	3	2
Less than 500	2	1

- The final entries will be evaluated based on the criteria mentioned in the Booklet by a panel of Judges.
- Each criterion carries points. These scores are collated, and final scores are graded as A++, A+, A.
- > The grades represent the performance of the participants as defined below:

> All participants will receive a Participation Certificate and the shortlisted graded entries will be awarded with a Merit Certificate.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

To mark the 75 glorious years of India's Independence, following events are proposed for the students of Indian Schools across Oman. Events for the day are chosen with an objective of creating a milieu of edutainment and feeling the festivities of the Mahotsav.

THEATRE

• Prop Box Play – creating a skit based on the given props. The props are to be utilized for creating their own ingenuous dramatic themes. The dramatic props offer children the freedom to express themselves and to exercise their imaginations. No prop should be used for its actual use. Number of actors should not exceed 10. (Two hours of preparation and 10 minutes of presentation)

General Rules

- > Performances shouldn't exceed the given time.
- > Medium of communication is English
- > The themes should be appropriate for school competitions and should

respect the culture and tradition of the sultanate of Oman.





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Criteria for Awarding Grades

- Plot 10 marks
- Creative use of props 10 marks
- Dialogue 5 marks

PAINTING

• Students will be asked to give a visual expression of India@100 on a given canvas (time given is 2 hours)

GENERAL RULES

- Canvas size (70x50cm).
- > A group can have maximum of 3 participants.
- > Participants are allowed to use any media (Water colour and Acrylic).





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Criteria for Awarding Grades

- Interpretation and clarity of the theme 10 marks
- Quality of artistic composition 10 marks
- Overall impression of the art 5 marks

POETRY

• Poem writing and recitation – Students will be asked to compose a poem on a given theme. The poem should appropriately depict the given theme. It can be written either in English or in Hindi. The finalists will be asked to recite their poems. (Time given to write the poem is 1 hour)

GENERAL RULES

- > Contestants may write a poem of their choice.
- > The poem should not exceed 500 words
- > Writing from a script will result in loss of points.
- > Political /religious sentiments should be avoided.





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Criteria for Awarding Grades

- Relevance to the theme 10 marks
- Diction and Imagery 10 marks
- Intonation and Expression 5 marks

INDIA @75 TED TALKS

• Public Speaking on given topics (30 minutes of preparation and 3 minutes of presentation)

GENERAL RULES

- > Performance shouldn't exceed the given time.
- > The order of speakers will be decided by drawing lots.

Criteria for Awarding Grades

- Content 15 marks
- Enunciation 5 marks
- Diction & Pronunciation 5 marks





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MEDLEY OF PATRIOTIC SONGS IN DIFFERENT INDIAN LANGUAGES

• Make a medley of patriotic songs in different Indian languages – the performance should be without any break. Number of performers on stage should not exceed 10. (Time given is 10 minutes).

GENERAL RULES

- > Songs Patriotic songs in different Indian Languages.
- > Only the song rendition will be assessed.
- > Religious and film songs are not allowed.
- > Use of pre-recorded music is not allowed.
- > The lyrics should be appropriate for school competition and should respect the culture and tradition of Sultanate of Oman.
- The lyrics to be sent to the host school on August 27, 2022 on or before 5.00 PM in the given email ID.



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Criteria for Awarding Grades

- Vocal (Rhythm and Tempo, Timing, Harmony) 10 marks
- Expression (performance, chemistry) 10 marks
- Showmanship (Show design, entertainment value, choreography) 5 marks

SCHOOL PAVILIONS

- Each School will be given a state for its pavilion. The visitors should get a feel of the profundity of India's culture and heritage.
- The venue and the allocation of space for each school will be decided by the organizers.



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SPORTS

All Sports events will be held from 7:00AM onwards (ISM Ground)
