# CIRCULAR TO PARENTS OF THE SCHOOL

Dear Parent.

## **■ FEE PAYMENT:**

Parents are reminded that the last quarter (January to March) fee is due for payment. Parents are expected to clear all the fee of their wards before 15<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

School fee for the full academic year must be cleared before 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019. Please note that the fee defaulters will not be permitted to appear for the final exams and also their names will be removed from the rolls. Transfer Certificates will be issued only after clearing the complete fee for the academic year. In case they want to continue their studies in ISM, they will have to go for new admission after clearing the dues.

Fee Counter is open on all Saturdays from 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

# CBSE CLASSES X AND XII BOARD EXAMINATIONS:.

CBSE has declared **date sheet** for Classes X and XII Board Examinations. It is available on Indian School Muscat website (www.ismoman.com) and also CBSE website – www.cbse.nic.in

Class X - From 21/02/2019 to 29/03/2019. Class XII - From 02/03/2019 to 04/04/2019.

It is mandatory for all students appearing for Classes X and XII examinations to pay their outstanding fees upto 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 and clear all the dues by the 7<sup>th</sup> of February 2019. Those who have already paid the fees may ignore this note.
