## Guidelines on Elections for Prefects, House Captains and Vice Captains

Dear Students,

Greetings from Indian School Muscat!

In continuation to the communication and filing of nominations, the school is ready to organise the elections for class Prefects, House Captains and Vice Captains on **Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020 from 6 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.** through Google ballots which will be sent to their school email IDs. Please read the following instructions carefully and follow the same for the smooth conduct of the elections.

- Students of Class IX will receive two ballots – one to elect the Class Prefects and the other to elect the Vice Captain.
- Students of Classes X & XI will receive three ballots – one to elect the Class Prefects, one to elect their House Vice Captain and the third to elect their House Captain.
- Students of Class XII will receive two ballots – one to elect the Class Prefects and the other to elect their House Captain.
- Each student has to write his/her name and GR No on the ballots.
- In order to elect the Class Prefects, every student should vote for two girl and two boy candidates.
- If there are only girl / boy candidates in a class, students need to cast their votes for two boy / girl candidates from that particular class.
- Certain sections of the Class may not receive the ballots for electing Class Prefects, it's because that class has no contestants, or there are candidates who have been already elected due to no contest.
- To elect the House Captain and the Vice Captain of a House, students need to cast their votes for only one candidate each.
- A 'Meet the Candidates' programme will be organised House-wise to get introduced to the candidates contesting for the posts of House Captain and Vice Captains on **Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020 at 5 p.m.** on Google Meet. A meeting link will be sent to the students as per their House. This programme will be organised under the supervision of their respective House Mentors and House Office Bearers. Each candidate can deliver a speech of introduction for not more than two minutes. While delivering the speech, the candidates are instructed to turn on their camera and unmute their microphones.
- There is no introductory speech for the Class Prefects.
