Circular to Students and Parents (Classes IX & XI- Revised)

Dear Students and Parents,

Greetings from Indian School Muscat

As we are going through an unusual situation, we need to ensure everyone's safety. You are requested to strictly follow the guidelines of the government by staying indoors and maintaining personal hygiene. Indian School Muscat has been conducting online webinar classes for the students of Classes X & XII since 30th March 2020. Now we would also like to roll out the online teaching-learning process for the benefit of our students of Classes IX & XI to help them to be engaged during these days. This will be webinar sessions through a dedicated school server for this purpose. Online sessions for class IX will start on Thursday, 9th April 2020, and for Class XI on Monday, 13th April 2020 (tentatively).

Please login to <https://vle.ismoman.com> using your GR number with school code '01' as your username and your date of birth without any space as your password. For example, if your GR number is 1234, your user name will be 011234. If your DOB is 21st March 2009, your password will be 21032009. Enter these details on the top right of the page and login.

Teachers shall engage the class as per the special time table that has been prepared for this purpose. These online classes shall be hosted from the teacher's house by using a user id and password. The topics that are taught during the online classes will not be repeated after school reopens. Homework /assignments will be given to the students to be practised at home. Each period will be of 40 minutes as per the time table.

While the teaching happens, students are requested to keep their mics muted and the video in off mode. Students can type their questions in the chat box and these questions will be answered at the end of the session. They are strictly instructed not to indulge in any unwanted activity during these classes, failing which stringent action will be initiated against such students.

I would like to request the parents and students to be patient till the students and teachers familiarize themselves with the new way of teaching-learning. It is normal to feel confused or frustrated in the first few days as technological or communication issues arise. However our computer teachers and HoDs will be there to provide teachers with the necessary support to make the process successful. Collectively, we can ensure the safety of our students and teachers, and the continuity of teaching-learning during these unexpected circumstances.
