CIRCULAR TO PARENTS OF CLASSES VIII, IX & X CBSE SCIENCE CHALLENGE 2025-26

Dear Parent, Greetings from Indian School Muscat!

Science is inexplicably linked with our lives and helps us to understand the world around us better. By engaging with this subject, students learn to think, solve problems and make informed decisions. As an initiative to generate curiosity, enquiry and higher order thinking amongst the learners, the CBSE is organizing the Science Challenge for the students of classes VIII to X.

This challenge shall be available on CBSE platform in the months of April - May, 2025. The theme of the CBSE Science Challenge is Science, Environment and Sustainability.

Details of the CBSE Science Challenge are as follows:

- The challenge will be conducted through **two rounds** within school, and inter school.
- There is **no fee** for participating students at either of the two stages of this enrichment activity.
- All students of classes VIII to X in CBSE affiliated schools are eligible to participate in Round One (first stage). For Round Two (second stage), each affiliated school registered in the first stage will nominate 6 students (best 02 students from each participating class) from the registered students.
- The Science challenge paper will comprise a variety of stimulants followed by MCQs. The task for participating students will focus both on speed and accuracy.
- All the participants of Round Two will be issued an online participation certificate by the Board. Appreciation Certificate will be given to the best performing students.

Round One of the CBSE Science Challenge will be conducted for all students of classes VIII, IX & X on Thursday, April 24, 2025 during the school hours. No retest will be conducted thereafter.
