INDIAN SCHOOL MUSCAT CLASS XI – ADMISSION CRITERIA (2022 -2023)

Only 40 students will be admitted in each of the classes. Kindly note that admission to Class XI is provisional and subject to Class X Board results and shall be based on merit i.e. percentage of marks. The given criteria are only the minimum percentage of marks for registration to a particular group. However, priority will be given to those students who secure higher percentage of marks.

Admission to Engineering Graphics, Computer Science, Informatics Practices and Mathematics groups will be strictly based on merit as the school has limited seats, i.e. 40 seats only.

Students seeking admission to Humanities Stream need to have the minimum pass marks subscribed by CBSE, i.e. 33% marks in each of the subjects in Class X.

There should be a minimum of 15 students to start a combination. If enough number of students do not opt for a particular combination, that group will not be started.

Preference will be given to students of Indian School Muscat for admission to all groups subject to fulfilling the above mentioned criteria.

The Provisional Admission to Class XI will be on the basis of the best marks of the three Pre-Board Examinations conducted in Class X during the academic year 2021-22.

Admission Criteria for Class XI (Non-ISM Students)

All those non-ISM students who secure at least 5% marks more than that of prescribed for ISM students shall be eligible to apply for admission to Class XI subject to the availability of seat in the particular group. Preference will be given to students of Indian School Muscat for admission to all groups subject to fulfilling the above mentioned criteria.

Sports Quota

We wish to recognize the contributions made by our students in the field of games and sports by awarding some weightage for their contribution. The details of the criteria taken into consideration are as follows:

One seat is reserved for sports students in each section of Class XI and this seat will be allotted to the deserving student on the basis of the following criteria:

- \checkmark The student should have minimum of 40% marks in each of the subjects without moderation.
- ✓ He/she should have won at the Cluster level when he/she was in Class VIII or represented Oman and National Level Team. Since no sport was possible during the last two academic years (2020-21 and 2021-22), students' achievements during the academic years 2018-19 and 2019-20 shall be considered.

There shall be seats reserved for ECA and Sports in form of seat 10% (rounded off) (6% for sports, and 4% for others) of total seats and on 15th August 2022, the vacant shall be converted into general category. The weightage is as follows. The following relaxation in terms of marks will be given:

Kindly note that any student who hold represented the National team will be given stream of his/her choice subject to Board results.

- Relaxation shall be applicable with regard to all minimum percentage criteria fixed viz. subject & aggregate.
- Only those students deputed by the school for the events/disciplines shall be considered. Individual performances in disciplines outside ISM structure shall not be given weightage.
- Only the performance in Class VIII at ISM will be considered. No weightage shall be given to a candidate who has not studied in ISM in Class VIII. However, candidates coming from India may be considered with regard to their performance at Zonal/National level subject to submission of verifiable valid documents. Only the highest level of performance will be considered.
