- 1. The election will be held on Saturday, 11 January 2020 from 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. at ISM New Multipurpose Hall.
- Kindly bring your Resident Card for voter's identification. No other identity card will be entertained as voter's identity. You are required to enter the school only through the main gate. Photocopies of the resident card will not be considered as voters' identity.
- You are entitled for only one vote for each set of parents irrespective of the number of children you have and the person who casts the vote will only be allowed to enter school premises.
- Please cast your vote in favour of only one candidate. You may Mark
 or X in "Your choice" column against the candidate you wish to elect. Unclear / multiple marking on the ballot paper will invalidate the vote.
- You are bound to follow all traffic rules in front of the school during the election time. You are advised that no crowding will be allowed in front of the school. You are, therefore, **urged to follow these instructions** strictly to avoid any unpleasant situation.
