17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas 2023

- 1. The **17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas 2023 Convention** will be held in **Indore (Madhya Pradesh)**, India from **8-10 January**, **2023**.
- 2. The theme of the 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas (PBD) Convention 2023 is: "**Diaspora: Reliable Partners for India's progress in Amrit Kaal".**
- 3. The 17th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas Convention will include five Plenary Sessions on the following themes :-
- Plenary Session I: Role of Diaspora Youth in Innovation and New Technologies
- **Plenary Session II**: Harnessing the Potential of Women Diaspora Entrepreneurs towards an Inclusive Approach to Nation Building.
- Plenary Session III: Leveraging the Soft Power of India- Goodwill through Craft, Cuisine & Creativity
- Plenary Session IV: Exploring Links between Skills and Migration Trends of Indian Workers Abroad
- **Plenary Session V**: Role of Indian Diaspora in promoting India's healthcare ecosystem in the Amrit Kaal: Vision @2047
- 4. **30 eminent diaspora members will be honored with the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman Awards** during the 17th PBD Convention.
- 5. It is advisable that the delegates attend all the events relating to PBD 2023 Convention on 9 and 10 January 2023. Delegates are also welcome to attend Youth PBD programme on 8 January 2023.
- 6. Registration for participation in PBD 2023 Convention is mandatory for all participants, including official delegates, invited guests, government officials, artists and performers and journalists. Registration will be only through an online process.
- 7. All PBD delegates/participants are required to pay the registration fee (except Government of India's special invitees). In addition to individual registrations, Group registration facility can also be availed by PBD delegates, who wish to participate as members of an Indian Association, Community organization or Professional organization. The registration fee will include meals (lunch and dinner at the Convention venue) during the event period. A Conference bag with programme, access to lunch and dinner venues, cultural programmes will also be provided to the participants on arrival. Delegates can pick up the Conference Bag from the special counters set up at the PBD Convention venue from 8 January 2023. The details of registration fees for individuals and group registration is given below.

20% discount in Registration Fees for early registration (registration before 15 November 2022). Early Registration Discount and Group Registration Discount can not be availed together.**No refund to be provided in case of cancellation of Registration**.

8. While registering online using the registration form, fees may be paid online itself. In case the payment does not process/fails, an option to complete the payment later is available using Login credentials sent on registered Email ID.

9. You can avail an early bird discount of 20% if you register before 15 November 2022.

10. There will be no refund in case of cancellation of registration.

11. Regarding visa requirements, If you are a Non-resident Indian national (holder of Indian passport), you don't require a visa to travel India. If you are a person of Indian Origin, your valid PIO or OCI card can provide visa free entry to India. If you do not have a PIO or OCI card, please apply at the nearest Indian Embassy or consulate for a visa. Foreign passport holders are advised to apply well in advance for Visa. You may please apply for "Conference Visa" to attend PBD 2023 Convention. Confirmed registration for the PBD Convention will be required at the time of submission of visa application forms at the Indian Embassy/High Commission/Consulate. If you are a special Invitee of the Government of India, please present the invitation letter from the Ministry of External Affairs, along with the

visa application to the Indian Embassy/Consulate to obtain gratis Visa. For more details regarding visa, please visit: <u>https://indianvisaonline.gov.in</u>

12. All registered participants/delegates will be provided a delegate card/badge which they would be **required to wear all time at the convention venue**. PBD registered delegates can collect the badges/cards at the special registered counters at PBD Convention venue set up for the purpose.

13. Entry to the PBD Convention will only be given to **the person who has registered**. A photo ID and verification proof need to be shown to obtain the delegate badge for entering the PBD convention. The delegate cannot transfer his badge to any other person.

14. A limited number of hotel accommodations are available in Indore. A list of hotels which have offered special rates for PBD Delegates/Participants is on the website. Bookings can be made online through the web portal link of the hotels, or for the Government of India invitees, accommodation would be arranged by the organizers.

15. Links are provided on the website for tourist attractions in Madhya Pradesh. Special tour packages have been curated for PBD delegates by Madhya Pradesh State Tourism Development Corporation.

16. PBD delegates based outside India are advised to bring medical and travel insurance for the period of their stay in India.

Registration Guidelines

Individual Registration

- 1. Go to https://pbdindia.gov.in/register-now
- 2. Select the box REGISTER AS AN INDIVIDUAL. Select any one of the following categories- Indian National, Non-Resident Indian, Person of Indian Origin.
- 3. Fill in the necessary details on the page. Fields marked with asterisk (*) are mandatory.
- 4. Click on REGISTER.

Group Registration

A minimum of 10 members are required to register as a group.

- 1. Go to https://pbdindia.gov.in/register-now
- 2. Select the box REGISTER AS A GROUP.
- 3. Fill in the necessary details on the page. Fields marked with asterisk (*) are mandatory.
- 4. The Coordinator of the group needs to fill the form. Mention the Name and Email Address of the Coordinator accurately as any further information would be sent to him/her.
- Upload a Group Document in the PDF, DOC, DOCX, XLS, XLSX formats. A Group Document is a document containing Full Name, Email ID, Phone Number, Passport Number, and Nationality of all the members of the group who wish to attend the PBD 2023. (sample document – Annex-2).
- 6. Click on REGISTER.
- 7. In the next step, the Ministry of External Affairs would contact the Coordinator and connect them with the Person In Charge from respective Embassy.
- 8. The Embassy would provide a Unique Coupon Code to the Group Coordinator which should be shared with the relevant members only.
- Each member of the group now has access to the Coupon Code. Now each member of the group needs to register individually by clicking on 'Register as an Individual'. Using the coupon code, the individual members of the group can avail the group discount.

Payment Process

 All major cards from Indian and International Banks are accepted. The payment options available are Debit/Credit Cards, Internet Banking, and UPI. However, you need to first select the payment gateway. There are three **Payment Gateways** - State Bank of India, Axis Bank, and Bank of Baroda.

- 2. A Payment Gateway only facilitates payment transactions. It does not imply that the payment options are restricted to only State Bank of India, Axis Bank, and Bank of Baroda.
- 3. After selecting the payment gateway, you can find the 3 payment options-Debit/Credit Cards, Internet Banking, and UPI. Fill in the details and make the payment.

For Users of Indian Banks

- Debit Card (MasterCard/Maestro/Visa/Rupay)
- Credit Card (MasterCard/Visa/Amex/Rupay)
- UPI

For Users of International Banks

- International Debit Card (MasterCard/Maestro/Visa)
- Credit Card (MasterCard/Visa/Amex/Maestro)

Registration Fees

All delegates/participants of PBD convention 2023 are required to pay the registration fee. The registration fee includes meals (lunch and dinner at the Convention venue) during the event period. A Conference bag with programme details, and passes for lunch and dinner venues will also be provided to the participants on arrival. Delegates can pick up the Conference Bag from the special counters set up at the PBD Convention venue from 8th January 2023 onwards.
