Classes IV to XII	Postcard writing	Unsung Heroes of Freedom Struggle or My Vision for India in 2047



10 best entries will be selected and uploaded by the school.

Parents of students in classes IV to XII, are requested to collect the postcard from the School Gate by mentioning the student's GR No., class and section at the designated time and date. The duly filled in postcard should be submitted at the school gate on or before December 15, 2021 during the school working hours. Any delay in submission will not be entertained.

Out of the total, 75 best postcards will be selected by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) at the national level. After the selection process, the entries will be forwarded to the Department of Posts (DoP) for participation in the final event. The final round will be conducted in the third or fourth week of January 2022.
