Dear Parents,

The International Award Programme for young people, popularly known as the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme is an important co-curricular activity in our school. The award scheme has three levels with each level having four constituent sections viz. Service, Skills, Physical Recreation and Expedition exhorting increased level of commitment and effort. The entrants will be guided in their programme by their teachers and adult volunteers.

The three levels of the Award are –

**Bronze Award:** A Bronze award can be achieved in six months.

**Silver Award:** A Silver Award which can take one year demonstrates the habit of maintaining the good work exhibited in all the four sections and carrying it beyond the Bronze level. This level substantiates how good habits are created, nurtured and sustained for common good.

**Gold Award:** The Gold Award is usually achieved over a period of one and a half year and is intended to encourage responsible adulthood and citizenship.

**Criteria for an award:** Registration for this programme does not guarantee an award but the entrants are assessed by a regional body of the Award Foundation in all the four sections i.e. Service, Skills, Physical Recreation and Expedition before conferring the Award.

The International Award Scheme Certificates of Participation and Awards are recognized and held in high esteem all over the world.

I strongly recommend you to encourage your ward to join this scheme. If you are interested in your ward joining this scheme, please pay RO 30/- towards registration fee only at the school fee counter.
