# CIRCULAR TO PARENTS OF THE SCHOOL

Dear Parent,

Greetings from Indian School Muscat.

Indian School Muscat urges the parents to follow the **COVID 19** awareness and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health, Sultanate of Oman and take necessary precautionary measures at all times. By considering the prevailing conditions and new developments, we request all parents and students to stay safe at home.

The school will remain closed till further intimation or announcement from the Ministry of Education.

#### • FEE PAYMENT

Fee Counter is open on all working days from 8.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. Please follow the safety guidelines by wearing the mask and follow social distancing protocols while coming to pay the fee.

Parents are reminded that the **Third Quarter (October to December 2020) fee payment is overdue.** Those parents who have not paid the fee of their wards are requested to remit the fee without any further delay as per the details mentioned in the School's website <a href="http://ismoman.com/feestructure.html">http://ismoman.com/feestructure.html</a>.

The Fee breakup provided in the school website includes the relief measures announced by the Board of Directors, Indian Schools in Oman to support the parent community due to the rising financial and socio-economic impact of Covid-19 pandemic. As per the BoD decision, we have provided 50% Tuition Fee Concession to the Children of Financially Challenged parents in the unfortunate situation in which any member of the Indian School family - parents or students contract the SARS CoV-2 infection and become Covid-19 positive. The above mentioned Fee Concession is applicable to only those applications received till 31 August 2020 as per the decision by the Board of Directors of Indian Schools in Oman. In addition to the above, RO.1.000 Fee increase in Tuition Fee is waived off during the period from April 2020 to October 2020 and only Tuition Fee is charged from May to August 2020 for all the students from Classes KG to STD XII. Further to the above discounts, BoD has announced 10% discounts in the monthly fee of September and October 2020.

Those who have already paid the excess fee in Quarter-1 and Quarter-2, the same will be adjusted in the next quarter fee payment. The yearly onetime fee applicable for the respective classes can be paid during the year as per the convenience of the parents along with the Third/Fourth Quarter Fee. The quarterly/monthly fee details are also available on the Online Parent Portal, ISM Mobile App and in the online Payment portals.

The School Fee can be paid through online banking or mobile banking by using the following means.

# 1. BANK MUSCAT MOBILE BANKING & ONLINE BANKING

Parents may use the online payment options like Bank Muscat Online/Bank Muscat Mobile Banking. There are no additional charges for electronic payment. Please choose "INDIAN SCHOOL MUSCAT" from the available options for the above online transactions and mobile banking.

# 2. BANK MUSCAT CDM

The School fee can be paid by using CDM of Bank Muscat by selecting School Fee Payment. Please select "INDIAN SCHOOL MUSCAT" only from the list of schools available for any transaction through CDM of Bank Muscat. Please do not select "INDIAN SCHOOL" from the list for CDM transactions since it belongs to another school.

# 3. FEE PAYMENT THROUGH ONEIC BILL PAYMENT (TASDEED, NBO, OAB, BANK SOHAR & NIZWA BANK)

Indian School Muscat has tied up with ONEIC/Tasdeed – Oman's trusted leader in electronic payment solutions to facilitate online fee payment through their website (www.tasdeed.om) and KIOSK at various locations using any of the debit/credit cards.
