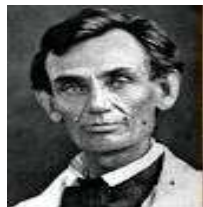

Sarojini Naidu has often been referred to as the 'Nightingale of India' because of her contribution to poetry. She is one of the most prominent women to take an active part in the freedom struggle.

By the time she joined the movement, the freedom struggle was already taking a definite shape. She was arrested and imprisoned several times for her political activities.

Her famous works are **Golden Threshold, Bird of Time and Broken Wing.**
