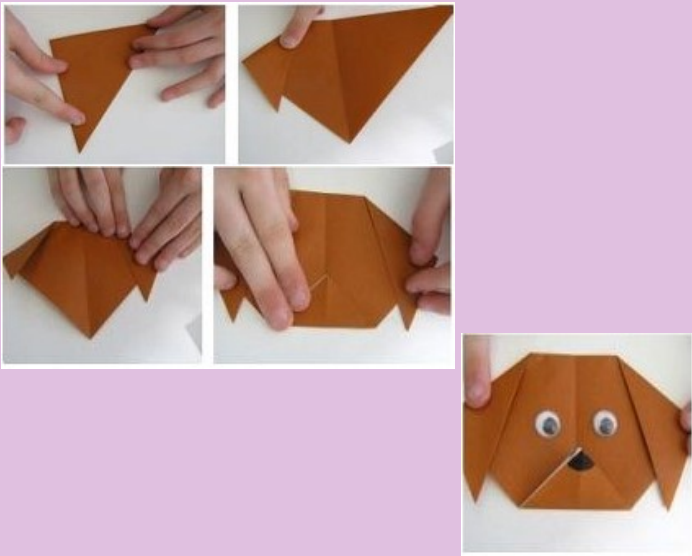

These activities can be carried out with the readily available materials at home. The ultimate aim of teaching is also achieved and it will be shared twice a week.

### BONE TO BOON



**Materials Required:** This craft can be done using any form of paper instead of origami paper.

- Take a square paper and fold it to make a triangle.
- Unfold it and fold both the sides as shown in the picture to make ears.
- Now, make a triangle fold from the bottom of the paper to make mouth of the dog.
- Take a black marker pen; draw the nose part and eyes for the dog.

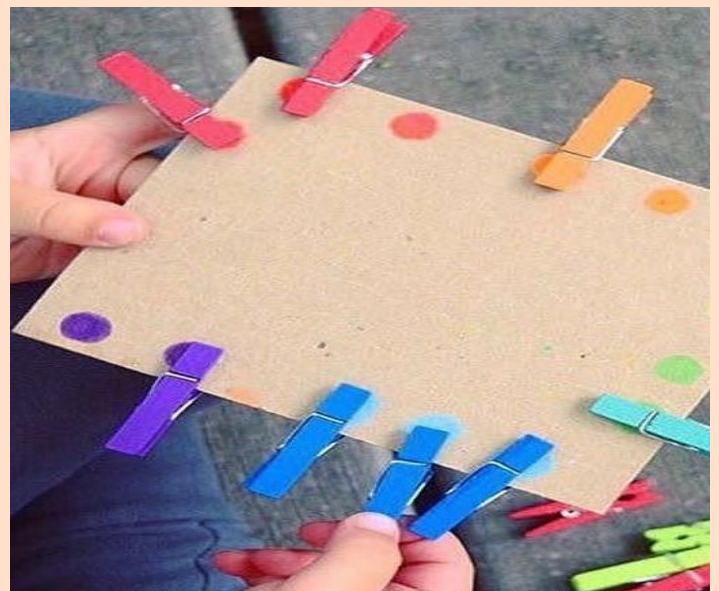
Advantage of this activity - It enhances eye – hand coordination, develops observational skills, gaining knowledge about origami, and increases finger grip.

**Materials Required:** Any card sheet/ cardboard, crayons/sketch colours, coloured pegs.

- Cut the cardboard/card sheet of any shape.
- Use different colours to colour on the edges of the card board.
- Now take coloured pegs and start placing according to the colour.
- You can also help your mom to put the pegs on the clothes.

This fun activity enhances eye – hand coordination and helps in identification of colours.

### FINGER GYM

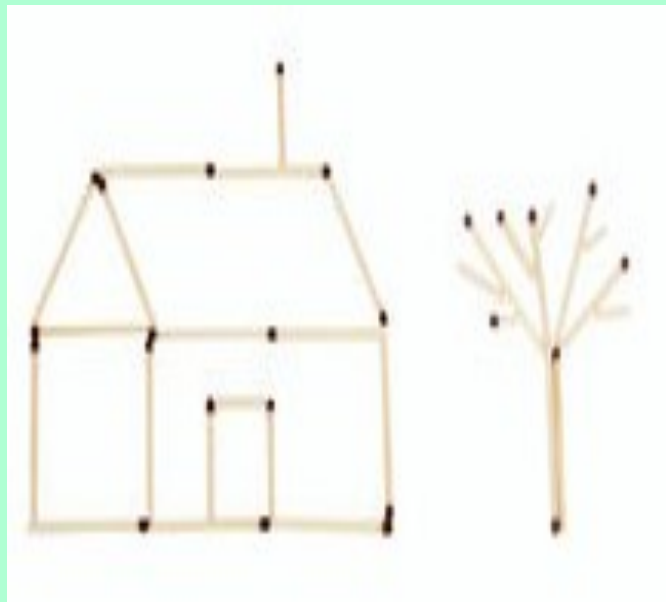


**Materials Required:** Matchsticks or toothpicks or similar size sticks which are easily available at home, glue stick, waste papers like old magazines, newspapers, or any paper which are easily available at home.

- Take the sticks which you have chosen and stick them on a blank paper making an outline of any picture of your choice, eg., a house, a boat, etc.
- Then fill the outlined picture neatly with the bits of crushed paper.

Advantage of doing this activity will improve the fine motor skills in children.

## FLUFFY SNOWMAN



**Materials Required:** Paper, Cotton, Glue, Crayons / Colour Pencils, old buttons.

- Take any piece of paper of your choice.
- Draw two circles (one small and one big), one below the other. Cut in such a way that you get an outline of a snowman. Now apply glue and stick cotton on these circles.
- Place buttons / pepper corns on small circle for eyes and buttons on big circle for snowman dress.
- Draw smiley, nose and cap on paper and stick on the small circle to make a smiling fluffy snowman as shown in picture.

This activity will enhance their eye-hand coordination.

**Materials Required:** Chalk, tape, any toy, small basket/bowl

- Mark any shape on the floor using tape or chalk as shown.
- Place a toy or any object in a small basket or a bowl.
- Ask your child to walk on the shape drawn on the floor by carrying the basket or bowl containing the objects on the head.
- Parents can change the shape drawn on the floor as per the child's convenience.

This activity improves gross motor skills along with balance and body control.
