SAVE THE MOTHER EARTH



Materials Required:

Any paper of your choice, pencil, eraser, crayons.

- Take a paper and draw a big circle.
- Draw two small circles as shown in the picture.
- Draw a mask as shown in the picture.
- Draw the eyes and hands.
- Colour the picture and write a message "SAVE ME!" on the paper as shown in the picture.

Learning Outcome: This activity teaches kids how we can save our Earth, if we stay at home and follow the safety measures.

Materials Required:

An old T-Shirt, A Pair of Scissors (to be used only by the parents)

- Take an old T-Shirt.
- Cut off the sleeves and collar.
- Make slits at the bottom, each about 1 inch long with a distance of 1 cm between each slit.
- Tie each slit with the opposite slit to make knots.
- You can now decorate the bag with buttons or sequins.

Learning Outcome: This activity instills creativity in children.

OLD IS GOLD

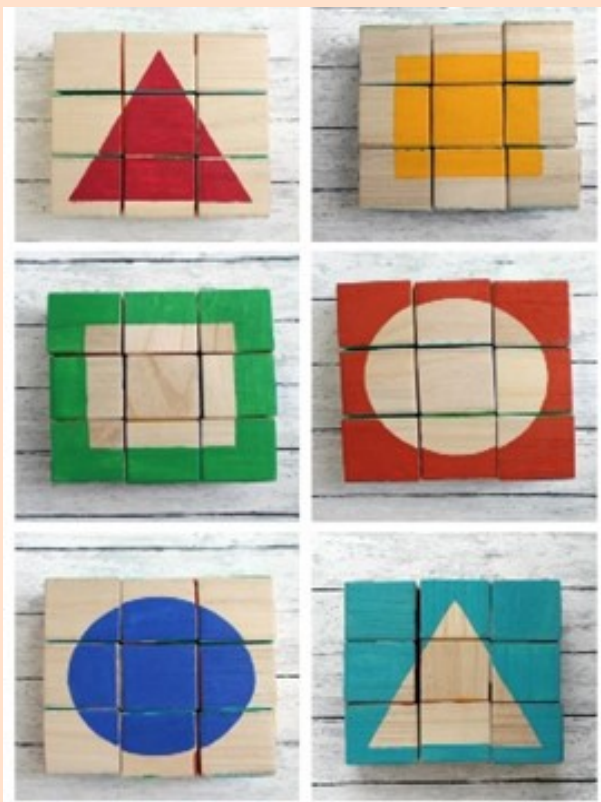


Materials Required:

Moral value based story books if available / create your own stories.

- Parents can inculcate good behaviour in children by narrating moral stories to teach about values like honesty, friendship, etc.
- Parents can develop praying habit in children.
- Parents can teach children the ways to communicate by explaining to them, how to speak and when to speak, for example: not interrupting while others are talking, waiting for your turn, not raising your voice unnecessarily, etc.

Learning Outcome: This activity helps to instill moral values and good habits in children, improves confidence and manage their feelings and emotions in a positive way.

MORAL BOOSTER**MIND MAP****Materials Required:**

Papers, pen/pencil, colour pencil/crayons, scissors.

- Draw any 6 shapes on a square paper or a cardboard sheet as shown in the figure and ask the child to colour it.
- Cut the pictures according to the marking into 9 equal pieces.
- Jumble the cut picture pieces and spread them on the table or on the floor.
- Ask the child to rearrange the pieces to create different shapes.

Learning Outcome: This activity helps in the development of analytical skills, betterment of eye-hand coordination and problem solving skills.
