SPARKLING YOUR GENIUS!



- Parents and child can play quiz at home.
- Parents can ask questions like:
 - Where does your mother cook food? Answer – kitchen.
 - ♦ In which room does the sofa belong?
 - O How many fans are there in the house?
 - ♦ Who is the tallest in the family?
 - ◊ What is the colour of the sky at night?
 - ♦ How many colours are there in a rainbow?
 - ♦ Which day comes after Thursday?
 - ♦ How many fingers do you have?

Learning Outcome: This activity will enhance parent child interaction and also help their socio-emotional and observation skills.


Materials Required:

Three identical cups or bowls and a small object (ball, coin, eraser etc.)

- Place the cups / bowls as shown in the picture.
- Place the small object (ball, coin, eraser etc.) under one cup in front of the child.
- Shuffle the cups / bowls around by sliding them across the table, switching their position quickly back and forth and all around.
- Once you have stopped moving the cups / bowls ask the child to identify the cup which has the object under it.

Learning Outcome: This activity boosts the memory power.

MIND MAZE



TWISTS AND TURNS





Materials Required:

Coloured blocks, soil, water, tray, keep ready any small plants of your choice in the glass / box.

- Take blocks and make different shapes of your choice.
- Remove the plants from the glass / box and place them in the block planter you have created.
- Add soil if necessary to pack the empty spaces.
- Pour little water into your colourful garden.
- Place the tray under the block planter to allow the water to drain.

Learning Outcome: This activity helps children to develop fine motor skills, eye-hand coordination and knowledge of improving creativity.

Materials Required:

Clock for timing, chits of paper to write the topics.

- Write the topics of stories on the chits of paper for example – Funny, Action, Horror, Adventure etc.
- Assemble in the living room, the first person picks up a chit and starts a story according to the topic written, for example – action story and finishes within the time decided by you. (one or two minutes)
- Now, the second person will pick up a chit and twist the story completely for example - from action to funny etc.
- The same continues repeatedly and the last person should give an end, filled with twists and turns.

Learning Outcome: This activity will enhance the child's observation skills and expression of ideas in a creative manner.
