The teaching methodology for Pre-Primary section is activity based. Hereby, we provide you with a list of activities that can be conducted at home under the guidance/supervision of parents. These activities can be carried out with the readily available materials at home. The ultimate aim of teaching is also achieved by carrying out these activities, and it will be shared twice a week.

### TOWER BUILDER



**Materials Required:** A tray / bowl, few toothpicks / ice cream sticks / straws and clay / dough / marshmallows.

- Place the dough /clay/marshmallow as a base and then prick the toothpicks/straws/ice cream sticks on it.
- Flatten a ball of dough/clay/marshmallow and prick all the toothpicks/straws/ice cream sticks (as shown in the given picture).
- Repeat the above steps to create a tall tower.
- Alternate method: Make small balls of dough and prick the toothpicks/ice cream sticks/straws in it to create any shape (eg. square, triangle and rectangle).
- Then, create a tower as shown in the given picture.

**Learning Outcome:** This activity helps to develop creativity and eye-hand coordination in the child.

**Materials Required:** A cardboard box/plastic box, cardboard tubes/paper towel rolls/ rolls made of chart paper, glue stick, different coloured tapes/threads and a small ball or bead which are easily available at home.

- Take any cardboard box with a smooth surface for the ball to roll on.
- Cover the tubes with coloured tapes or threads as shown in the picture.
- Stick the tubes on the cardboard surface making a maze on it.
- Then, ask the child to try and roll the ball through these coloured tubes.

**Learning Outcome:** This activity enhances eye-hand coordination and fine motor skills.

## COLOURFUL MEMORIES



**Materials Required:** Old CD/DVD according to availability, different coloured papers/charts, scissors, ribbon/wool and glue.

- Choose a design of your choice, for example – a fish, flower, house etc.
- Cut the outline of the selected design and decorate it in a colourful way.
- Place the CD in an appropriate position on the design as shown in the picture.
- Stick one of your favourite pictures in the middle of the CD.
- Stick a ribbon behind this frame and hang it on the wall.
- Your colourful photo frame is ready now!!!

**Learning Outcome:** This activity enhances creative skills in children and helps them to learn about recycling.

## WALKIE TALKIE

**Materials Required:** Two paper cups/ matchboxes, two paperclips and cotton string / thread.

- Make a hole at the bottom of each cup.
- Insert the string through the hole and make a knot. Put a paper clip on the knot to keep it in place.
- Now, insert the other end of the string through the hole of the second cup and tie it in place.
- Hold one cup and give the other to your partner with whom you will converse.
- Stand at a distance from each other until the string is stretched tight and start your conversation on the paper cup phone.



**Learning Outcome:** This activity will enhance the child's listening skills and knowledge of how sound waves travel.
