

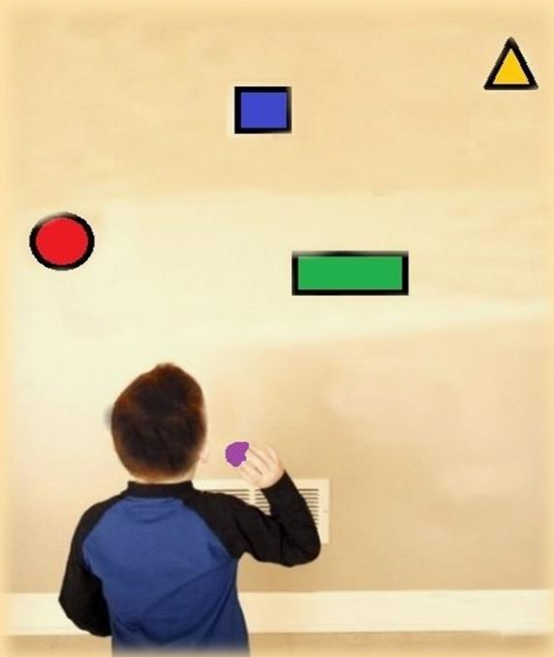


Dear Parent,

The teaching methodology for Pre-Primary section is activity based. Hereby, we provide you with a list of activities that can be conducted at home under the guidance/supervision of parents. These activities can be carried out with the readily available materials at home. The ultimate aim of teaching is also achieved by carrying out these activities, and it will be shared twice a week.

### HIT AND MISS



**Materials Required:** Ball, paper, colours or crayons and pencils.

- Draw any shapes, alphabets or numbers on a paper and stick it on the wall with proper spacing as shown in the picture.
- Let your child stand at a comfortable distance away from the wall.
- Ask him / her to aim at the shape/number/alphabet that you call out using the ball.
- For every right throw, you can draw a star on his/her hand.

**Learning Outcome:** This activity improves eye-hand coordination and develops concentration.

**Materials Required:** Any type of paper, scissors and glue.

- First, trace all the family members' palm prints on any paper.
- Next, cut out these palm prints carefully. You can also write the name of each member on the respective prints.
- Finally, glue them together according to the sizes as shown in the picture.

**Learning Outcome:** This activity enhances creativity and encourages family bonding.

## MOUSE MAGIC



**Materials Required:** A pair of scissors, any plain paper of your choice, glue and pencil/marker pen.

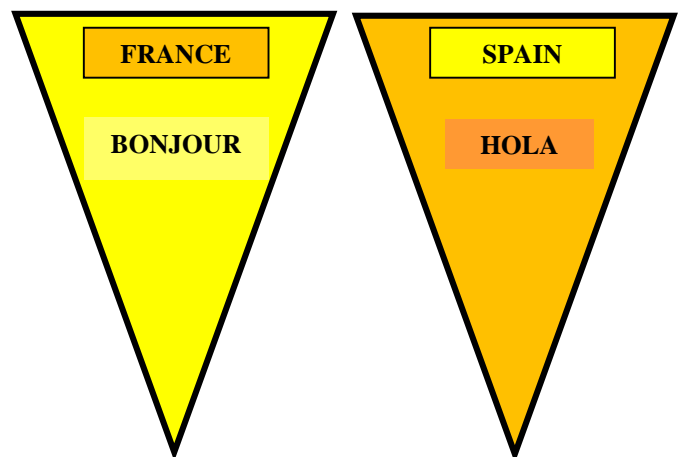
- Take a rectangle piece of paper.
- Fold the paper into half to fit on the thumb as shown in the picture.
- Glue the paper along the edges to form a mitt, leaving the bottom part open.
- Cut the top corners of the mitt, in a curved shape, to make the face of the mouse.
- Cut out two ears and teeth for the mouse as shown in the picture.
- Next, glue these ears and teeth on the mouse.
- Use a pencil or a marker to draw eyes and other details on the mouse.
- The finger puppet is ready!

**Learning Outcome:** This activity aids in improving fine motor skills and creativity.

**Materials Required:** Paper, marker/ colour pencils and scissors.

## CONNECT THE CULTURE

- Make a list of 3 or 5 countries and learn to say 'hello' in different languages. For example: BONJOUR – French, HOLA- Spanish, Italian, OLA- Portuguese, SALAAM- Persian (Farsi).
- Take a paper and cut it into triangular shapes.
- Write the name of the country and hello (in the language spoken in that country) on the triangular shapes as shown in the picture.
- Now, say hello in the different languages that you have listed.
- Once this word is done, choose another one and thus enrich your child's vocabulary.



**Learning Outcome:** This activity will help the child to learn about countries and the different languages.
