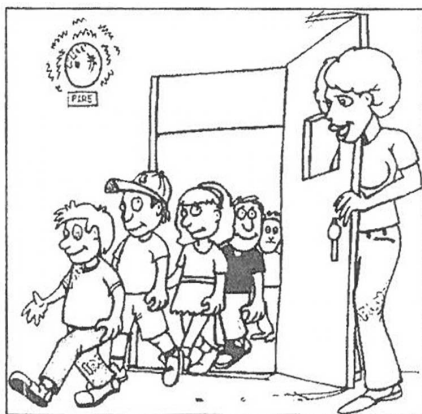

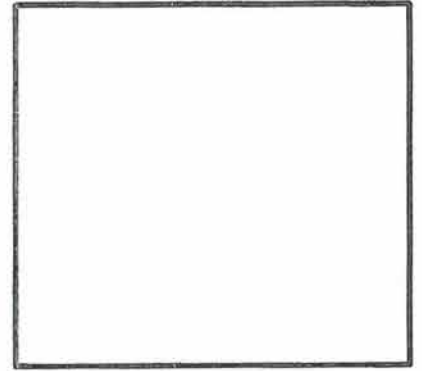

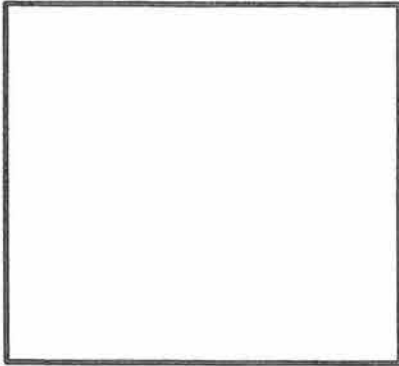


II. Read the statements given below and stick the correct picture that describes the First aid to be given.

b) Advise the casualty not to speak, swallow, cough, spit or sniff as it may disturb the blood clots.

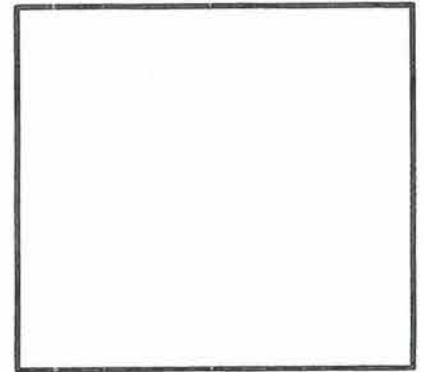

- a) Keep the person still and calm. Call for a doctor.
b) Immobilise the broken bone with a splint or a sling. Possible splints include a rolled up newspaper or strips of wood.

3. a) Drain out the water or other matter from the lungs.
b) Give artificial respiration.



4. a) Stand on dry insulated material like wooden planks, folded newspaper, rubber mat etc.
b) Break electrical contact without directly touching the casualty.
