The sugarcane plant is a giant grass that grows all year round in warm and wet climate.

Tall sugarcane stalks grow in clusters. The stalks are light yellow to green, purple or red in colour.

When the crop is ripe, the farmers remove the leaves from the stalk and trim them. The stalks are then washed and cut into equal lengths.

They are loaded onto the trucks and sent to sugar factories. In the sugar factory, the stalks are pressed between heavy rollers which squeeze out sugar cane juice.

Sugar cane juice is heated till it begins to boil. The juice is allowed to boil till all water dries up. The sugar syrup obtained is slowly heated till sugar crystals are formed.
