General

- This activity is open to the students studying in Classes I to XII.
- This is a solo event.
 - Only the registered students can participate in this event.
 - It is conducted in two categories: Sub-Junior, Junior and Senior
 - Students of Classes I to IV belong to Sub-Junior Category, students of Classes V to VIII belong to Junior Category and Classes IX to XII belong to Senior Category.
- All the participants will be given e-certificates of participation.
- Winners in each category (First three positions) will be given certificate of talent.
- Last date for the submission of entries is August 8, 2021.
- Artwork should be uploaded in the form link given in the flyer by August 8, 2021

Specific Rules

- Topic: Any one of the Indian Art Forms/Paintings (List is attached)
- The size of the artwork: A4
- Medium: Any (No digital work is accepted)
- Think freely, imagine without restriction, and develop your own identity.
- The artwork must be original. You should not copy someone else's artwork or shots from the internet and another source that can be used as a reference.
- Take a good snapshot of your artwork with a mobile phone or a camera. Edit the snapshot in the mobile phone or on the computer and write your full name, class, and section in the artwork. File (JPEG) size should not exceed 1 MB. The painting in jpeg format should be uploaded in the Google form.
