Students must follow the guidelines given below to attend the event:

- Students of Classes X and XII who are asked to register by the school will receive a QR code from the Embassy. All students must carry a copy of the QR code, without which entry will not be permitted.
- It is mandatory for all participating students to carry their Resident Card. If required, students may carry cash or a card in case they wish to purchase items from the food outlets located inside the venue.
- All students must be dressed in their regular school uniform, wear their school ID card, and maintain proper grooming.
- Students are instructed not to bring water bottles, snacks, books, or mobile phones, as these items are not permitted inside the venue. The school will provide refreshments during the day.

The school will arrange transport to and from the venue. Parents are requested to drop their ward at the school at 6:00 a.m. and pick them up at 1:00 p.m. from the school.

Teachers-in-charge will accompany the students, and their contact numbers will be shared via WhatsApp by the class teachers. For further information, parents may contact the teachers-in-charge.
