CIRCULAR TO PARENTS OF THE SCHOOL (KG to STD XII)

(Update on School-Monitored Transport Facility - Effective from Academic Year 2026–2027)

Dear Parents,

Greetings from Indian School Muscat!

The safety and well-being of our students remain at the centre of every decision taken by the School Management Committee and the School Administration.

Over the past several years, Indian School Muscat has facilitated a school-monitored transport system operated by private transport providers. This initiative was introduced to offer parents a structured and safety-oriented option, supported by defined guidelines and monitoring mechanisms.

A recent comprehensive review of the system indicates that utilisation of the school-monitored transport facility has remained limited, with approximately 7% of the total student strength opting for this arrangement, while the majority of parents have continued to make independent transport arrangements.

Given the limited adoption of the facility, continued institutional monitoring to ensure uniform compliance across all routes and operators has become increasingly difficult under the present framework and presents governance challenges that are not considered sustainable in the long term.

Accordingly, it has been decided to discontinue the school-monitored transport facility with effect from the Academic Year 2026–2027. From that date, the School will not provide, approve, or monitor any transport services, and all transport arrangements will be made directly between parents and private transport providers of their choice.

The School will continue to engage with relevant authorities and stakeholders in promoting general student safety awareness and responsible road practices.

Parents are kindly requested to take note of this update and make appropriate transport arrangements for the forthcoming academic year.
