6.	<b>Free Style Dance</b>	I & II	One Free style Dance composition.	3 minutes max.

### **Please note:**

- All items will be online solo performances on Zoom/Google Meet.
- All the participants will receive an e-certificate for their participation.
- Students showcasing their best performance will receive an e-certificate of Recognition.
- It is an open invitation to all the students for a three-minute performance.
- The performances of the students will be evaluated by a panel of judges.
- The panel will select the Best Performances and the decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- **Costume: Modest clothing.**

## **RULES & REGULATION:**

- A. **Indian or Western Light Vocal Solo** – For Indian music, only Decent Songs/Film songs, such as Folk Songs and Patriotic Songs are permitted. Prior-approval is required for the film songs. For Western music, English Motivational & Inspirational songs are permitted. The lyrics of the song should be appropriate for the school. Students can use an instrument / karaoke to sing along. The performance should not exceed 3 minutes.
- B. **Indian or Western Instrumental solo - (Percussion & Non- Percussion- any one instrument)** Students can select any one instrument for the performance. The performance should not exceed 3 minutes. Percussion and non –Percussion instruments will be judged separately.
- C. **Classical Dance of India- Bharatnatyam** - You can perform one Bharatnatyam Dance composition. Your costume should support your performance and it should be as per the school standard. The performance should not exceed 3 minutes.
- D. **Folk Dance of India-** You can perform any one Folk Dance form of India, such as Rajasthani, Haryanvi, Punjabi, Asami, Bengali etc. Your costume should support your performance and it should be as per the school standard. The performance should not exceed 3 minutes.
- E. **Contemporary Dance** – In this you can perform Contemporary style Dance. Your costume should support your performance and it should be as per the school standard. Performance should not exceed 3 minutes.
- F. **Free Style Dance (Classes I & II only)-** In this you can perform Free Style Dance. Your costume should support your performance and it should be as per the school standard. Performance should not exceed 3 minutes.

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**Note: Students need to introduce themselves at the beginning of their performance with GR number, Name, Class & Section.**
