#### **FEE PAYMENT**

Fee Counter is open on all working days (Sunday to Thursday) from 8.15 a.m. to 12.45 p.m. during the Summer Vacation (June 9, 2024 to July 28, 2024).

Parents are reminded that the First Quarter (April - June 2024) fee payment is overdue and the payment can be made with the applicable fine on or before 15<sup>th</sup> June 2024 to avoid further increase in the fine.

The Quarter Wise fee details and the fine structure for the year 2024-25 are available on the Student Diary, School website, and Online Parent Portal/Mobile App. The existing fee structure is followed in the new academic year 2024-25. The school fee can be paid monthly or quarterly as per the breakup given in the school diary and website.

# 1. NEW PAYMENT GATEWAY FOR THE ONLINE BANKING

Of all the 406 students of class XII who appeared for the CBSE examination, 29.06% of students secured overall A1 grade. The overall school average of 82.7% average of the Humanities Stream 84.7% Science Stream 82.2% and Commerce Stream 80.9% is highly commendable.
