Greetings from Indian School Muscat!

FEE PAYMENT

Fee Counter is open on all working days (Sunday to Thursday) from 7.15 a.m. to 2.30 p.m. and on all Saturdays from 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. Please follow the safety guidelines by wearing the mask and follow the social distancing protocols while coming to pay the fee.

Parents are reminded that the Fourth Quarter (January to March 2022) fee payment is

overdue. As the academic year is nearing end, parents are requested to clear all the fee dues of their wards on or before 15th March 2022. The results will be processed only after the payment of Fee dues for the Academic Year 2021-2022. Report Cards/Books for the next academic year will not be issued to the Fee Defaulters.

The Quarter Wise fee details for the year 2021-22 are available on the School website and Online Parent Portal/Mobile App. The School Fee can be paid through online banking or mobile banking by using the following means.

2. BANK MUSCAT CDM

The School fee can be paid by using CDM of Bank Muscat by selecting School fee Payment. Please select "INDIAN SCHOOL MUSCAT" only from the list of schools available for any transaction through CDM of Bank Muscat. Please do not select "INDIAN SCHOOL" from the list for CDM transactions since it belongs to another school.
