1. Product identification : An idea should lead the entrepreneur to a definite product/service	
which he can sell. So the first step is to obtain a concept of the product or service suggested by one idea. We should also see whether this product is already available in the market or	
not. If it is, then we should identify the reason for introducing the same product or service in	
the market. For example, innovating a new pendrive especially for teachers which will have	
a built in antivirus and which can be worn like a watch so it minimises the problem of losing	
the pendrive.	
2. Application and use: Ideas should be examined for their real life use and application. If it	
already exists in the market, we will have to find out its present use, then we may think of	
modifying it for better use. In the above mentioned example, we can clearly see that even	
though there are many companies manufacturing pendrives, the latest will be in consonance	
with the upcoming trends.
