	Stamping tool is used for copying the pixels from selected portions of an image to a destination area, the user wants to cover, or for reproducing the selected portions of an image. It uses the current brush to copy from a source. 2 Marks	
g.	Write note on i) Tileable Gaussian Blur - It merges, blurs, and wraps the borders of an image making it appear like a tiling concept. It reduces edge effects. Blur vertically or horizontally options could be set, besides radius and type of blur regions. ii) Pixelize - It is known as Abraham Lincoln Effect and converts an image into an array of solid squares. V a.	Mention any two steps you would take when the keyboard or mouse is not responding/working properly. Check Connections: Check the connection of the keyboard to the computer. Check for any Damage: Inspect the keyboard cord for any damage. If any damage is found, the keyboard may need to be repaired or replaced. This can be achieved as follows: Open the Windows Explorer Application and click on My Computer Highlight the C drive and right click to get a pop-up menu. Select the Properties option from this popup Menu. The dialog box showing the properties of the local disk (C:) is displayed. Choose the Tools Tab of this application.
