Ensure that all connections are tight, correctly plugged in, and the Power button of these devices is ON. For wireless devices, make sure it is turned on and the batteries are charged.</p> <p>Use Help: Access the Help window by pressing the F1 key. This window helps to find a solution to the problem.</p> <p>Record Error Messages: Record the full error message for future reference.</p> <p>Restart the Computer: Restart the peripheral device. 11.	<p>Run a Disk Clean Up Application- To get some more disk space, run the Disk Cleanup Application. On the General tab shown click on the Disk .Cleanup button, to start disk cleanup.</p> <p>Delete Unused Files and Programs-Periodically delete files and programs you do not need.
