- Two years ago Mayank obtained a degree in food technology. For some time he worked in a Q23 company that manufactured bread and biscuits. He was not happy in the company and decided to have his own bread and biscuits manufacturing unit. For this, he decided the objectives and the targets, and formulated an action plan to achieve the same.

One of his objectives was to earn 50% profits on the amount invested in the first year. To achieve this, it was decided by the purchase department that the raw materials like flour, sugar, salt, etc. will be purchased on two months credit. Mayank also gave instructions to follow the steps required for marketing the products through his own outlets. He appointed Harsh as the Production Manager who decided the exact manner in which the production activities were to be carried out.

Harsh also prepared a statement showing the requirement of workers in the factory throughout the year. Mayank informed Harsh about his area wise sales target for different products, for the forthcoming quarter. While working on the production table, a penalty of ₹ 150 per day was announced for not wearing the helmet, gloves and apron by the workers.

Quoting lines from the above paragraph, identify and explain the different types of plans discussed here.

- Q24 Elaborate any five features of management.
- Plant Products was engaged in the business of food processing and selling its products under a popular brand. Lately the business was expanding due to good quality and reasonable prices. Also with more people working the market for processed food was increasing. New players were also coming to cash in on the new trend. In order to keep its market share in the short run the company directed its existing workforce to work overtime. For the same work, the company paid less wages to its female workers compared to male workers. But this resulted in many problems.

Due to increased pressure of work the efficiency of the workers declined. Sometimes the subordinates had to work for more than one superior resulting in declining efficiency. The divisions that were previously working on one product were also made to work on two or more products. This resulted in a lot of overlapping and wastage. The workers were becoming undisciplined. The spirit of teamwork, which had characterized the company, previously was beginning to wane.

Workers were feeling cheated and initiative was declining. The quality of the products was beginning to decline and market share was on the verge of decrease. Actually the company had implemented changes without creating the required infrastructure.
