



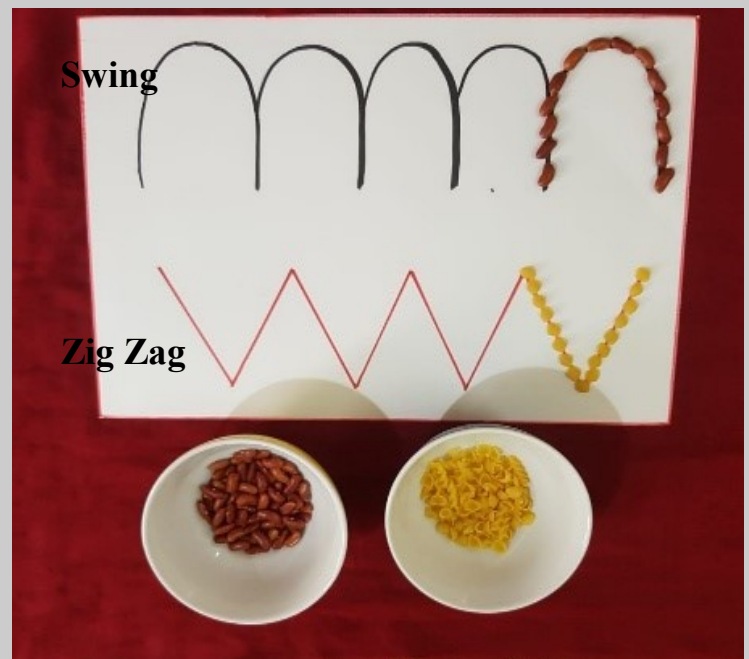
Dear Parent,

The teaching methodology for Pre-Primary section is activity based. Hereby, we provide you with a list of activities that can be conducted at home under the guidance / supervision of parents. These activities can be carried out with the readily available materials at home. The ultimate aim of teaching is also achieved by carrying out these activities, and it will be shared twice a week.

Kindly requesting parents to share photographs of your ward doing these activities.

PULSE PATTERN - SWING & ZIG ZAG

- Chart Paper
- Colour Pencil / Pen
- Any pulses available at home (Rajma / Dal / Chana)
- Make the following pattern on a paper.
- You can draw Swing / Zig Zag Patterns.
- Let your child pick the pulses one at a time and place them on the pattern you have created on the chart as shown in the picture.



WATER BOOSTER

- Fill a small tub with water.
- Collect few objects from around the house like Paper Clip, Ball, Pencil, Leaf, Coin, Spoon, Keys, Bottle etc.
- Parent can quiz the child before starting this activity about which object will float and which will sink.
- Ask them their reason for this prediction.
- One by one place the objects on water and observe. For every correct prediction, parent can reward the child with a hi-five!
- This experiment will help enhance the child's questioning, planning and problem solving skills.



FUN ACTIVITY - QUIZ TIME

Parents can conduct an oral quiz, by giving relevant questions.

- Which animal gives us milk?
- Can you tell, the name of an animal that has a long neck?
- Which animal makes the sound of bow-wow?
